

Fort Vancouver Lions Club & Foundation Board Meeting Friday, June 17, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. Fiesta Bonita Mexican Grill

Queen Lion Cheri called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. standing outside the restaurant.

Board Members Present: Queen Lion Cheri, Gay Enyeart, Martha Johnson, Michele Druschel, Mike Cavanaugh, Pati Sluys, Allen Rhyasen and Shelly Brown. Lions Helen & Terry Sutfin, and Larry Brown also were present.

Lion Cheri began the meeting by discussing the important task we all have as Board Members. She was reminded that she has a great support system of previous leaders who she can call upon when needed.

Standard Reports to the Board:

Secretary's Report: Lion Gay made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 13, 2022 Board Meeting as presented. Lion Martha seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report: Lion Rick emailed the Financial Reports to the Board for April and May. He was not able to attend the meeting to give a report. Lion Gay made a motion that any Lions whose dues are not current by June 30, be dropped from the membership. The motion was seconded by Lion Michele. The motion was passed by the Board. A suggestion was made that the dues statements be mailed in April or May to give members time to pay their dues before the June 30 deadline.

Due to the nature of our club's budget, Lion Rick sent a list of the charities and the amounts he recommended we contribute to each. After some discussion, Lion Allen made a motion that we accept Lion Rick's proposal and make these donations before the end of June. Lion Martha seconded the motion. The motion was approved by the Board.

OLD BUSINESS:

Redistricting Vote: Lion Cheri reported that the Redistricting vote passed 60-40%. There is no immediate change to our club, but it does have a significant change to our Zone leadership.

LCIF Chair Visit: Lion Helen Sutfin thanked our club for becoming a Model Club. Our club has \$12,000 remaining to be donated before June 2023. We will get a special recognition from LCI when we complete that commitment. Lion Helen reminded us that when we have fundraising events, we should keep our Model Club Commitment in mind. She also stressed the importance of participating in our Lions Council on the third Tuesday of each month. She also recommended visiting other clubs to meet other Lions. Lion David Rich will be taking over this position for the 2022-2023 Lions Year.

2022-2023 Vacant Officer Positions: Our club is still in need of two 2-Year Directors and a Lion Tamer.

NEW BUSINESS

Ilani Opportunity: The Board agreed to send out the opportunity to participate in this event. Lion Shelly will send out the email from Lion Dean.

Remote Option: After a discussion about keeping the Zoom option available, it was decided that we would continue to keep the Zoom option available. We want to eliminate a barrier for those who are not able to be at the meetings.

July Meetings: Due to the holiday, it was decided that we should not have our regular first Friday meeting on the Friday of the Fourth of July. We will have our meetings on **July 8** and **July 22** at Fiesta Bonita. The Board Meeting will be held on July 15 at 9415 NE Fourth Plain Blvd., Vancouver, WA 98662.

Installation Dessert: The invitation has been sent to the club. Lion Cheri suggested that we divide out the membership roster to call and give a special invite. Lion Martha will divide out the names in the roster for Board Members to call.

Food Drive: Lion Martha suggested that we have a summer Food Drive.

Frozen Berries Sale: Lion Allen reported that we have a Frozen Berries Sale delivery coming up on August 27. Lion Cheri requested that Lion Allen send the number of Frozen Berries needed to sell that will make up for the lower number of Fresh Strawberries sold.

Shred Event: Lion Allen also reported that we will be having a Shred Event tentatively scheduled on Saturday, October 8, 2022. More information will be coming soon.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:35 a.m.






