Member Wins: Board members shared their wins for the previous week.

Standard Reports to the Board:

Secretary's Report: Lion Cheri made a motion to accept the minutes from the September 9, 2022 Board Meeting as presented. Lion David seconded the motion. The motion was approved by the Board.

Treasurer's Report: Lion Rick gave a report on the first quarter of this Lions year. The credit card system is working very well! Lion Rick will have the information about members who still have outstanding dues for the November Board Meeting. Lion David made a motion, seconded by Lion Martha to give Lion Rick the approval to write off the past due dues for the following Lions for the 2021-2022 Lions year: Dixie Hotaling, Katrina Galicz, Craig Lyons, and Darvin Zimmerman. She is recruiting volunteers for the Art Night on October 27th. The Thanksgiving lunch has been cancelled by the Vancouver School District, so we won't be going to serve on November 17.

Clark County Relay: Lion Cheri gave an update on the Snack Booth at the Clark County Relay. Cheri's company made a donation to the Relay for Life. She shared a flyer she made describing our club to hand out at this event. She is looking forward to improving our part of this project for next year.

Gee Creek Updates: Lion Martha received feedback about the Gee Creek rest area. There are no open dates until June. There are many restrictions to what you can serve. This idea will be shelved for now.

Santa Store: The Santa Store is looking good. Lion Martha talked with Lion Eva to verify that we have all the gifts needed for this year's project. Lion Martha said we will need about 200 grocery size paper bags, as well as 30 red and/ or green tablecloths. Lion Cheri will take care of the tablecloths. The sign-up sheets will be coming out in November.

New Location Committee: Lion Cheri discussed ways of making our current location more workable. It was proposed that we have a number system for our orders or possibly ordering online. Lions are encouraged to arrive early to order and get lunch before the meeting starts.

December Christmas Meeting: Lion Cheri will be working with Lions Martha and John to make plans for our December Christmas gathering.

FVLC Sunshine Committee: Lion Cheri would like to get the sunshine committee more involved with communicating care to our members. She asked us all to think about ideas and share them using the Leadership email.

Foster Kids Christmas Gifts: Lion Eva has requested that our club members help with buying gifts for Foster Kids. The Board was really excited to be able to help with this! An email will be sent out to club members.

Salvation Army Bell Ringing: Lion Martha suggested that Lion Cheri contact Lion Doug and Lion Tracy about chairing this event.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:50 p.m.
